## The 13th Annual Interior Design Show kicks off with a charitable opening night bash

The 13th Annual Interior Design Show (IDS), Canada's largest contemporary design fair, kicked off with an opening night party attended by 5,000 held at the Metro Toronto Convention Centre. This year's International Guests of Honour included Allegra Hicks, Darryl Carter, Doug Coupland, Jean-Marie Massaud, Michael Young and Thom Mayne.

Guests enjoyed an exciting array of tantalizing food and beverages, and participated in interactive performances, all surrounded by 300 exhibitors showing the newest design products. The IDS11 Opening Night Party's charitable partner was Casey House. In a unique fundraising campaign, 20 of Canada's most celebrated designers and architects were tasked with rethinking and reimagining one of the design world's most iconic pieces — the Vitra Panton Chair.

Since its inception, IDS has welcomed over 550,000 visitors, close to 5,000 media, and provided a marketing platform for almost 4,000 individual designers, studios, firms and companies.
